

Easy To Build - Wooden Lawn / Camp Chair



2x10x8' Pressure Treated Board

Cut 1 - Cut board equally into 2 4-foot sections (labeled "A" and "B")

Cut 2 - Measure & mark a 5" section extending from the end of one end of piece "B" to within 10-inches of the other end. Cut the outside edges away. These are scrap.

Cut 3 - Measure & mark a 5-1/4 x 2" tall section extending from 13-1/2" of one end of piece "A". Drill a hole into this section, and cut it out. It should be 2" tall by 5-1/4" wide.

Your seat is now essentially finished. Slide the 5" wide section of piece "B" through the hole in piece "A". I like to round off all the edges of the backrest and the seat. Another thing that is not necessary - but makes the seat more stable on the ground - is to cut an angle on the bottom edges of each piece to make the bottom edges parallel with the ground. This gives more surface area for the seat that is in contact with the ground, and helps prevent tip-overs.
